1. Course Registration System

Please note that Course Registration is done via <u>CourseReg@EduRec</u> (<u>myEduRec</u> > Academics > Course Registration). Please take note of the various dates for each course selection round as stated at the <u>CourseReg Schedule</u> Course Selection **Round 1** starts on **22 July.** Please refer to the attached email from OUR for more details.

Refer to the CourseReg website <u>https://nus.edu.sg/coursereg/index.html</u> for the detailed information. Please look through the <u>User guide</u> & <u>Videos</u> if you need a refresher on how to use the system.

You will also need to make your <u>Academic Declaration</u> before you can access CourseReg. Students are required to complete their Academic Plan declaration at least 24 hours before participating in the CourseReg Exercise. The Academic Plan Declaration page is accessible from **15 July (9am).** You may refer to the user guide <u>here</u>.

Please note that for your Academic Plan Declaration, there is **<u>no necessary</u>** to declare any CEG 'Specialisation' or 'Tracks' (not applicable for CEG). You will not be able to select them in CourseReg as they are not configured for your selection. It is not compulsory to declare any major/minor especially you are in your first semester & if you are unsure whether to take a 2nd major/minor. Students may declare their 2nd major/minor in subsequent semesters

NOTE 1: The core courses will be pre-allocated to you only if you have fulfilled their prerequisites. Please refer to the Recommended Schedule for CEG students at <u>https://ceg.nus.edu.sg/students/studyschedule/</u> (look for Recommended study schedule for AY23/24 intake students) for the courses you are recommended to take in this semester.

NOTE 2: If you want to re-take any year 1 core course(s), you are required to select for the course(s) via CourseReg from Round 1 onwards. You may contact me (comlowmb@nus.edu.sg) if you have further queries on re-taking these courses. Please check the schedule to ensure that there are no timetable clashes with your year 2 core courses.

NOTE 3: Students who are required to take (ES1000/ES1103) English courses may select a sectional group from Round 1, 22 July. You should read and pass this English requirement in Sem 1, AY24/25. The pre-req for ES2631 is ES1103. Please refer to <u>https://wiki.nus.edu.sg/display/eng/Bridging+Courses</u> for details.

If you did not see any courses, please check if you have completed the two e-courses 'A Culture of Respect and Consent" & 'Student Essentials'. Please ensure that you have completed them, otherwise courses cannot be allocated to you.

Please note that priority to read EE2026 in sem 1 goes to EE students, as per their recommended schedule. If still keen to read, CEG AY23 intake may try to select EE2026 from Round 3 (5 Aug), subjected to quota availability.

NOTE 4: Workload Policy for first two Bidding Rounds

For students with a GPA of **more than or equal to** 2.0, the maximum workload (preallocated & selected courses) is **strictly 23 Units for Rounds 1 and 2**. From Round 3, you will be able to see your max number of units you can take when you click on 'Select Courses' in CourseReg, which is dependent on your GPA. Please evaluate the maximum workload you can handle according to your capabilities, taking into consideration that the CEG core courses generally have a heavy workload. Do not take up to the maximum workload if you find it difficult to manage.

Please note that workload increase (if approved) will only take effect from <u>Round 3</u> <u>onwards</u>. Students can only select up to 23 units (inclusive of pre-allocated courses) in Round 1 – Round 2.

Please do not submit your appeal via coursereg for overloading as it will be rejected.
