**Kindly take note of the following important announcement:**

### **1. Freshmen Welcome / Important Curriculum Talk (19 July, Friday, 2-6pm)**

A reminder that the Freshmen Welcome / Curriculum Talk is on 19 July, at 2pm at LT7A (Blk EA). There will be an **important briefing on the CEG curriculum at 4pm**, we urged you to attend the Talk as we will present important academic issues, including your curriculum, timetabling matters, course planning, etc.

### **2. Course Registration System**

Course Registration is done via [CourseReg@EduRec](#) ([myEduRec](#) > Academics > Course Registration). Please take note of the various dates for each course selection round as stated at the [CourseReg Schedule](#). Course Selection **Round 1** starts on **22 July**.

You are also required to make your [Academic Declaration](#) before you can access CourseReg. Please **complete your Academic Plan declaration** (where appropriate) **at least 24 hours before** participating in the CourseReg Exercise. The Academic Plan Declaration page is accessible from **15 July (9am)**. You may refer to the user guide [here](#)

Please note that for your Academic Plan Declaration, there is **no need** to declare any CEG 'Specialisation' or 'Tracks' (not applicable for CEG). You will not be able to select them in CourseReg as they are not configured for your selection. If you did not accept any major/minor upon admission, it is not compulsory to declare any 2<sup>nd</sup> major/minor especially you are in your first semester & if you are unsure whether to take a 2nd major/minor. Students may declare it in subsequent semesters.

Do check your NUS email account regularly for updates on course and tutorial registrations for the coming semester. **All future email correspondences will be sent to your NUS email only & not to your personal email.**

You should have received an email from CDE Office of Undergraduate Programme (OUP) office, please read the email. See attached for reference.

Freshmen are required to complete two e-courses, on top of completing both Part 1 and 2 registration before they are considered to have completed matriculation. A reminder to

complete the two e-courses ‘A Culture of Respect and Consent’ & ‘Student Essentials’ if you have not done so. Otherwise, courses cannot be allocated to you as CourseReg will block your access to enrol courses, you will be tag with Negative Service Index (NSI).

**NOTE 1** CG1111A lecture & lab slot will be pre-allocated by ECE Office in Round 1. Email to Ms Winnie Chua at [cegcwn@nus.edu.sg](mailto:cegcwn@nus.edu.sg) if you have queries on CG1111A. Please do not select other course that clash with your CG1111A allocated slots. **Due to the lab constraint, students are NOT allowed to change the lab group assigned.** If you wish to do so, please submit your appeal via Coursereg with your details (i.e. name and student ID and lab group of yourself and your peer) for a mutual swap.

**NOTE 2:** Please select both MA1511 & MA1512 as both are 2 units courses sharing the similar timetable and should be taken in the same semester. E.g. MA1511 (Week 1-6), MA1512 (Week 8-13).

**NOTE 3:** Results of QET will be released online on 22 July 2024 [here](#).

- Students who obtain Band 1 will have to take ES1000 followed by ES1103.
- Students who obtain Band 2 will have to take ES1103.
- Students who obtain Band 3 are exempted from these English courses.

Round 1 (22 July) onwards. Students not required to do ES1000/ES1103 may select a GE course (GE courses available from Round 2). Please do not select any GE courses that have timetable clash with your pre-allocated courses.

**NOTE 4:** 'A' level students without 'A' or 'H2' level Physics (or its equivalent) are required to take PC1201 as a bridging course, in semester 1 (which will be pre-allocated by OUP); **please email me to highlight this (no 'A' level Physics or equivalent) if you have *not* done so.** You will postpone ES1103/UEM till another semester.

**NOTE 5:** The **maximum workload** is a total of **23 units** in Sem1 AY24/25. For students in special programmes (E-Scholars, DDP, USP, etc), the maximum workload will be capped at 27 units. Only students in the above listed approved special programmes will be able to select beyond 23 units, but only in Round 3. Note that the 23units max workload is strictly enforced by the university for freshmen, no exception will be granted.

The minimum semestral workload is 18 Units Refer to [Undergraduate continuation and graduation requirements](#) for details.
