NOTE 3: Workload Policy for first two Bidding Rounds

For students with a GPA of **more than or equal to** 2.0, the maximum workload (preallocated & selected courses) is **strictly 23 Units for Rounds 1 and 2**. From Round 3, you will be able to see your max. number of units you can take when you click on 'Select Courses' in CourseReg, which is dependent on your GPA. Please evaluate the maximum workload you can handle according to your capabilities, taking into consideration that the CEG core courses generally have a heavy workload. Do not take up to the maximum workload if you find it difficult to manage.

Please note that workload increase (if approved) will only take effect from <u>Round 3</u> <u>onwards</u>. Students can only select up to 23 units (inclusive of pre-allocated courses) in Round 1 – Round 2.
