Please note that the viewing/application period for ATAP/DTLP is now open on NUS TalentConnect. Please also note that more roles will progressively be available so please check back frequently.

1. Internship Application Timelines

	ATAP Jan-Jun 2026*	DTLP Jan-Jun 2026*
Internship Period	5 January – 19 June 2026	5 January – 19 June 2026
Viewing & application	4 September – 14 November 2025	4 September – 14 November 2025

****For ATAP, the earliest an internship can begin in this cycle is 8 December, and the latest it can begin is 19 January but MUST fulfil 24 consecutive weeks. Submission deadlines will remain unchanged.***

Please note the following important viewing/application deadlines:
ATAP & DTLP – **14 November 2025 (Friday)**

Students will have 5 working days from issuance of offer to accept it before it expires.

2. Self-sourced Internships

If you have already secured an internship outside of TalentConnect, and are intending to convert it to a credit bearing one, you would need to submit the form at <https://soc-n.us/selfsourced>.

***If a job posting has already been approved (already viewable on TalentConnect), there is no need to submit the self-sourced internship form. Just apply for the position directly.**

Please note the deadlines for students to submit self-sourced internship conversions is as follows:

ATAP & DTLP – **5 December 2025 (Friday)**

No extension requests will be entertained.

3. Pre-application checklist

(i) Check Eligibility:

- You must satisfy the pre-requisites
- You cannot repeat Internship course code once cleared

(ii) Ensure your updated (1) CV/resume, (2) Transcript, (3) Cover letter are updated and uploaded to TalentConnect.

(iii) Ensure you have filled in the relevant SoC Experiential Learning Application (ATAP/DTLP). **If you do not fill this in, you will NOT be able to view postings.**

4. NUS TalentConnect

Please note that due to screening restrictions, Double Degree Programme students whose home faculty is not SoC may not be able to apply directly on NUS TalentConnect.

5. Experiential Learning Placement Form (This pops up after an offer has been accepted.)

This form (on NUS TalentConnect) is **NOT** used by SoC. Any submission of this form is not required and can be ignored.

6. Completing Internship Enrolment

Companies **MUST** extend offer via NUS TalentConnect, and Students **MUST** accept offer via NUS TalentConnect within 5 working days. Companies can write to our team at internship@comp.nus.edu.sg to request to reset expired offers.

Job Application Status is NOT recognized as a completed internship registration.
A completed enrolment will state the Offer Status as "Offer Accepted".

7. Internship Support Letters

SoC will only issue internship support letters if you have completed the formal offer acceptance process on TalentConnect. Requests can be submitted at <https://soc-n.us/internletter>

If a letter is required for your NS ICT Deferment Appeal, please submit your request at <https://soc-n.us/nsdefer>

8. Graduating after your internship

Students intending to graduate immediately after their credit bearing internship, should submit their appeal **BEFORE** to applying for internships. Students may submit their appeal here - <https://soc-n.us/finalesemappeal>
