Please be reminded that for your Academic Plan Declaration, there is **no need** to declare your

CEG 'Specialisation'. You will not be able to select them as they are not configured for your selection.

You should have received an email from CDE Office of Undergraduate Programme (OUP) office, please read the email as it contains details on the registration for Common Engineering courses. See attached for reference.

***NOTE 1:** The core courses will be pre-allocated to you only if you have fulfilled their pre-requisites.

In Round 1, students are able to select courses for Programme Requirements (e.g. Major, Minor, Technical Electives). NOTE 3: If you want to re-take any year 1 core course(s), you are required to select for the

course(s) via CourseReg from Round 1 onwards. You may contact me (farhan_shaikh@nus.edu.sg ; cc: comlowmb@nus.edu.sg) if you have further queries on re-taking these courses. Please check the schedule to ensure that there are no timetable clashes with your year 2 core courses.

NOTE 4: Workload Policy

For students with a GPA of more than or equal to 2.0, the maximum workload (pre-allocated & selected course) is **strictly 23 units for Round 1 to Round 2**. From Round 3, you will be able to see your max number of units you can take when you click on ‘Select Courses’ in CourseReg, which is dependent on your GPA. Please evaluate the maximum workload you can handle according to your capabilities, taking into consideration that the CEG core courses generally have a heavy workload. Do not take up to the maximum workload if you find it difficult to manage.

GPA	Max Workload (Round 0 to Round 2)	Max Workload (Round 3 onwards)
4.5 – 5.0	23 units	32 units
4.0 – 4.49	23 units	28 units
3.0 – 3.99	23 units	26 units
2.0 – 2.99	23 units	24 units
< 2.0	23 units	20 units

It is **not advisable to exceed beyond your maximum workload** (see above table). If you have strong reasons to appeal beyond your maximum workload, please email the following info to your **Year 2 Academic Coordinator, Dr Sangit Sasidhar** (elebox53@nus.edu.sg) and cc your email to farhan_shaikh@nus.edu.sg and comlowmb@nus.edu.sg .

- (i) Total units planning to take in Semester 1
- (ii) supporting reasons
- (iii) Sem 1 workplan (course code, title and its respective units)
- (iv) personal details (matric no, degree level, GPA **before** S/U)

Please note that workload increase (if approved) will only take effect from **Round 3 onwards**. Students can only select up to 23 units (inclusive of pre-allocated courses) in Round 1 – Round 2.

Please do not submit your appeal via courserereg for overloading as it will be rejected.
